To be eligible for Kindergarten, children must be five years of age before August 1, 2019.

To enroll your child for the 2019-2020 school year, please bring:

- Your child's birth certificate
- Your child's social security card
- Immunization records
- Proof of district residency
(City of New Haven utility bill, electric bill, property tax/real estate tax receipt, rental agreement)

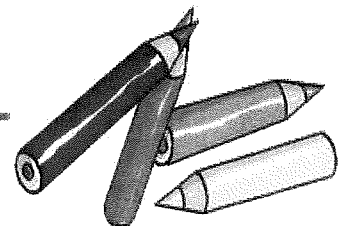
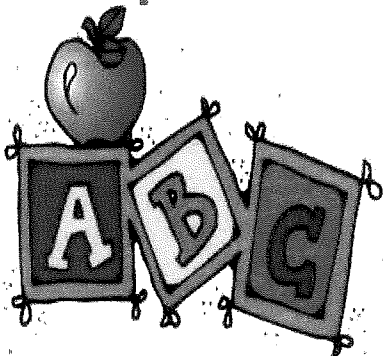
Children will be screened at the time of enrollment.

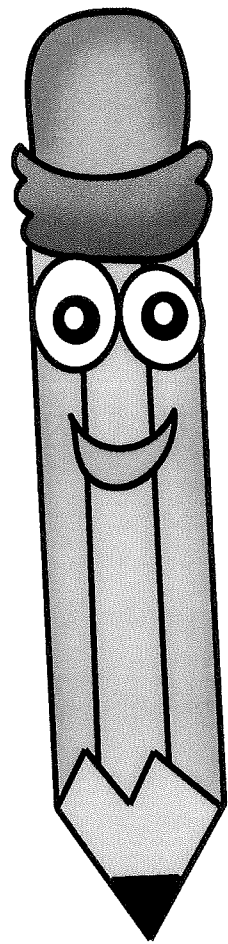
Please call the elementary school office at 237-2141 to schedule an appointment or if you have any questions. Each appointment lasts approximately one and a half hours.

Early Childhood Screenings*

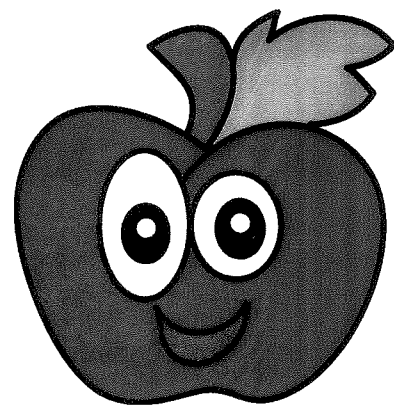
Children who are 4 years old by August 1, 2019 will be screened on Wednesday, March 20.

Please bring a copy of your child's current immunization records to the screening.
